## Architecture and Interior Design

The architecture and interior design majors utilize a robust set of computer applications. The applications are the same that are used in the design industry, and include:

- · Autodesk AutoCAD
- · Autodesk Revit
- · SketchUp
- · Rhinoceros
- · Rendering softcare and plugins such as V-Ray, Lumion, Enscape, and/or Unreal
- · <u>Creative Cloud</u> \$19.99 a month (Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign)

It should be noted, currently, <u>Autodesk Revit is a Windows</u> only program. Using a Windows operating system is most efficient on a PC, but there are methods of accommodating this on an Apple OS. An Apple iPad Pro or Google Chromebook are NOT an acceptable substitution for your laptop. Major specific applications are not compatible with these devices.
